- Boat handling and safety
- Boat carrying and launching
- Training on Concept2 rowing machines
- Training on the water
- Four weeks membership in novice crew (August 9 – September 4). The novice crew is made up of 2010 Learn to Row graduates.

Cost: \$250 (includes a 3 month membership at BIAC, including use of rowing machines, free introduction to sculling lessons in single person shells, use of single person shells)

Classes are Saturdays and Sundays from 9am to Noon
